Eligibility Criteria:

To be eligible to apply, applicants must represent either an intermediate, junior, or secondary school within a Canadian public or separate school board. To ensure compliance with CRA rules for registered charities, the school board must meet the criteria for a “*qualified donee*” as defined by CRA (e.g. the school board is a registered charity).

Instructions:

Educator to complete the application form and provide a signed letter of support from the school board/institutional administrator.

Selection process:

Applications will be reviewed and adjudicated by an advisory panel of CWB Group’s Senior Leadership Team. Award decisions are the responsibility of the CWB Welding Foundation and are approved by its independent Board of Directors.

Application Process:

Applicants must provide a completed application. The following information is required:

1. An overview of welding programs currently in place (including programs offered, number of instructors and level of student participation).

2. A description of the project and its origins

3. Project drawings

- Agree to include the organization's name and photographs in any internal and/or external communications or marketing collateral that the CWB Welding Foundation deems appropriate.
